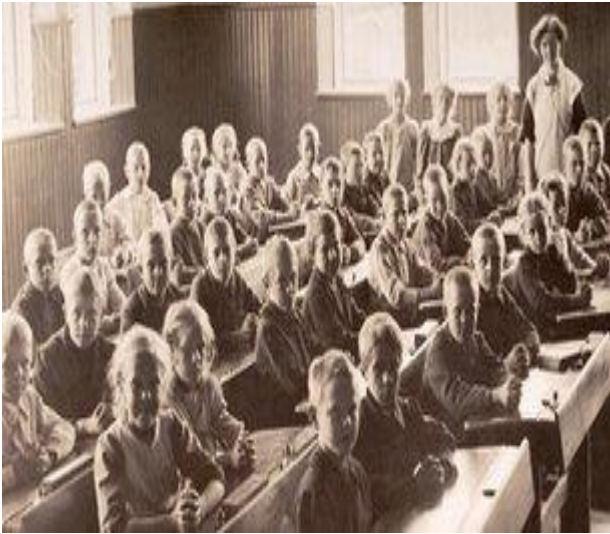


My life as a woman in WW1 by Kacper



Hi, my name is Sare. I live with my family. I work at the Ammunition Factory. I have 2 children, one is a boy, the other one is a girl. The boy's name is Jonathan and the girl is Winter. When I go to work, my mum and my dad take care of the children. My job involves making ammo so soldiers can use them. My husband died, last time I got a letter from him a year ago. My boy is 6 years old and the girl is 7 years old. When this war ends, I will want to become a teacher.

My job is the Ammunition Factory; it involves making ammo for soldiers. I am not enjoying my job as an Ammunition worker. I have to get up at 06:15 to get to work. I get 2 shillings each week. I come back from work at 18:45. I work 12 hours and 30 minutes. My job is not dangerous. At the end of the day I feel happy because I will see my children.



I live with my family. I have 2 children and it takes me 2-4 hours to wash their clothes. When someone has broken clothes from my family, I stitch the clothes and then I'm done. When I do dinner for my children, I give them Bread, ham and cheese. A housewife looks after my children. It takes me 1 hour to wash my children. When my children have to go to school, housewife needs to get them ready to school, it takes here 30 minutes to get them ready. When my children come back from school, I'm not there because I'm at work.
